- **Educational Support and Learning Materials:** Providing essential resources for children in rural Nepal to enhance their learning experiences.
- **Long-term Support for Families:** Initiatives that promote acceptance, understanding, and ongoing support for families affected by learning differences.

The Made in Nepal Fair is organized by the Reporters Club Nepal Canada (RCNC), which has been leading this initiative since 2023. Over the past three years, RCNC has spearheaded
